W. E. Holbrooks
All those two tracts or parcels of land in Gant
township County and State aforesaid first known
as the Mill tract no. 8 of the John T. Kerns Estate
containing fourteen and three quarters acres
more or less ($17\frac{3}{4}$) beginning at an iron pin
corner of tract nos. four and 7 thence due east
12.6 chains to an iron pin, thence N. 2 E. 10.30 chains
thence N. W. 9.30 chains to an iron pin, thence
N. 88 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 1.17 chains to an iron pin, thence S.
18 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 18.58 chains to beginning.
