(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

W. D. Workman,
All those certain lots of land situate in the second ward in the city of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being lots nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the plat of the property of C. C. Hurdman made by P. E. Dalton, Engineer, December 1917 and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the northeast corner of Jackson Street and Markley Alley (said point being four feet north of the original line of Markley Alley); thence with said new line of Markley Alley (said line being four feet north of and parallel with the old line of said Markley Alley) S. 67-13 E. 100 feet to an iron pin on nine ft. alley; thence with said alley N. 20-55 E. 105.4 ft. to an iron pin on 16 ft. alley; thence S. 67-10 E. 100 ft. to an iron pin on Jackson St; thence with Jackson Street S. 20-55 W. 102 ft. to the beginning corner.
