KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Henry L. Smith, of the City of Greenville, in said County,

in the State aforesaid,

for the sum of Ten dollars, and for other good and valuable consideration DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by John T. J. D., Robert J., and  
E. F. Woodside, of the said City, County and State

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

John T. Woodside, J. D. Woodside, Robert J. Woodside and  
E. F. Woodside, share and share alike, and their heirs  
and assigns, all that certain lot, piece or parcel of  
land situate lying and being in the State of South  
Carolina and County of Greenville, in the fourth ward  
of the city of Greenville, having the following metes  
and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake on the  
west side of Brown Street between Washington Street  
and McGee Avenue, on the northeast corner of the  
McKay property, and running thence along (Brown  
Street N. 21° E. forty (40) feet to a stake on the south  
east corner of the lot conveyed by Mrs. Helena C. Poole to  
Mrs. Virginia D. Jones by deed bearing date September 11,  
1905 and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds  
Conveyances for said County and State in deed book 600  
at page 501; thence along line of the Jones lot N. 69° W.  
sixty-two (62) feet or more to a stake; thence along the  
Jones line S. 21° W. twenty-three and one half (23 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet  
to a stake; thence (still along the Jones line) N. 69° W.  
fourteen (14) feet to a stake on the north east corner of  
a lot conveyed by me, the said Henry L. Smith, to  
J. J. Westervelt and W. B. Smith by deed bearing date  
March 10, 1913, and recorded in said office in deed book  
no. 16, at page 78; thence along the Westervelt line S. 21°  
W. fifteen (15) feet and eleven (11) inches to a stake on the  
McKay line; thence along last mentioned line S. 69° E.  
seventy-six (76) feet more or less, to the beginning corner.  
This is a portion of the property which belonged to the  
late Henry M. Shumate at the time of his death, and which  
was adjudged to belong to S. Barron Grier, Joseph A. McCullough  
and myself by a decree rendered on September 17, 1909, in  
a case brought in the court of common pleas for said County  
and State by myself and others against John H. Shumate  
and others (see Judgement Roll no. 2. 3150) the said Grier  
and McCullough having conveyed to me their undivided interest  
in said land by deed bearing date October the 6 1909, and re-  
corded in said office in Book no. 4 of deeds, at page 749.  
My intention is to convey hereby all the land so vested in the  
said Grier, McCullough and myself by said decree except that  
portion thereof conveyed by me to J. J. Westervelt and W. B. Smith  
by the deed above referred to, and except the rights of way  
granted in said last mentioned deed in a lot of land  
measuring ten feet by sixteen feet conveyed eleven inches  
lying immediately back of the lot by me to said Westervelt as  
also all the right, title, interest, estate, claim and demand whatsoever  
both at law and in equity, which I have or might assert in and to  
the lot of land lying immediately north of the lot hereby conveyed  
being the rights of easement granted by Mrs. Virginia D. Jones by  
her deed of covenant bearing date September 11, 1905, and recorded in  
said office in deed Book 600, at page 657.
