COUNTY OF GreenvilleKNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That W. D. Workman, of the County
of Greenville, andin the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Ten (\$10) Dollars, and other valuable consideration
to me T. E. LaGronce
in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

T. E. LaGronce, his heirs and assigns forever.
 All that certain lot of land situate on the North side
 of South Main Street, in the City of Greenville, County of
 Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designa-
 ted as lot 23 on Plat of Thomas M. Walker Company's
 subdivision made July 1919, recorded in the R. M. C. Of-
 fice for Greenville County, Plat Book E, page 146 and hav-
 ing the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning
 at a stake on the North side of South Main Street
 at corner of lot 22 and running thence N. 10-11 W.
 145.52 feet to stake on South side of Chisora Street, thence
 with Chisora Street S. 80-15 W. 25 feet to stake corner of
 lot 24, thence with line of lot 24 S. 10-12 E. 144.46 feet
 to stake on South Main Street; thence with South Main Street
 in an easterly direction 25 feet to the beginning corner
 being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Thomas M.
 Walker Company, by deed dated the 9th day of August 1919,
 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in
 Vol 25, page #65.

As a part of the consideration hereinabove expressed the
 grantee, herein by accepting this deed expressly assumes
 and promises to pay a certain note, secured by mortgage
 on the above described premises, executed by W. D. Workman
 to Thomas M. Walker Company in the sum of Eighty five
 hundred (\$8,500.00) Dollars, dated August 9, 1919. The gran-
 tor guarantees that one thousand (\$1,000) Dollars has been
 paid on this note and the grantee is to assume the bal-
 ance of Seventy five (\$7,500) Hundred Dollars, payable
 \$2,500.00 two years from August 9, 1919; \$2,500.00 four years
 from August 9, 1919, \$2,500.00 5 years from August 9, 1919 to-
 gether with interest from August 9, 1919 at six per cent. (6%)
 payable semi-annually until paid.
 Taxes for 1920 to be prorated to February 1, 1920.
