(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

R. L. Crisshank and W. W. Dodson,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina in the City of Greenville on the west side of Brown Street described as follows: Beginning at corner of Carpenter Brothers Drug Company's lot and running thence with their line in a Westerly direction eighty feet to a ten foot alley; thence with said alley in a line parallel with Main and Brown Streets, thirty-five feet to corner of a ten foot alley extending from Brown Street; thence with line of said alley and parallel with the first line eighty feet to Brown Street, thence with Brown Street in a northerly direction thirty-five feet to the beginning, being the same land conveyed to me by Mary E. Mills, in her own rights, Mary E. Mills as executrix, and W. C. Cleveland, as executor of the last will and testament of R. L. Mills, deceased, and A. M. Rickman by deed dated 19th day of July, 1919 and recorded in Book 58, page 15.

This deed is intended to convey all my right, title and interest that I have in or to the use of the private alleys which bound the above described lot on two sides.
