KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, C. N. Ware, C. T. Ware,
C. M. Ware, and A. R. Ware,

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Six Thousand (\$6,000.00) DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by J. P. Jordan

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

J. P. Jordan, all those pieces, parcels or tracts of land situate, lying and being in Oaklawn Township State aforesaid, near the town of Pelzer, lying on the south side of Pelzer road and being known as tracts 1, 2 and 3 of sub-division of the "Salt Ware Place" as shown by plat made by H. N. Willis September 19, 1919 recorded at M. C. Office for Greenville County Plat Book 6, Page 152 and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the south side of Pelzer Road at stake corner of Oliver Ware Place and running thence with his line S. 25-30 W. 1130 feet to stake on Jordan's line; thence along Jordan's line N. 83-10. W. 1002 feet to stone; thence N. 22-16 E. 1389 feet to stake on Pelzer Road; thence along said Pelzer Road S. 68-15 E. 1034 feet to the beginning corner the three tracts together containing 2 6³³/₁₀₀ acres.
