DEED TO Nell G. Parrish & Louise C. Flower

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mary A. Beattie am my own
 right and as Executrix of the Will of John C.
 Beattie, deceased, and J. T. Beattie as Executor of
 the said Will

in the State aforesaid,

In consideration of the sum of
 Ten Dollars & other good & Valuable Consideration DOLLARS,
 to us in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by Nell G. Parrish & Louise C. Flower

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Nell G. Parrish and Louise C. Flower; - all that certain
 piece, parcel or tract of land situate on the Laurens
 Road about two miles eastward from the city of
 Greenville County and State aforesaid and more par-
 ticularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake
 in the center of the Laurens Road corner now or
 formerly of Webster, and running thence N. 25° E. 20. 65
 chs. to a stone; thence N. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ pl. 6. 80 chs. to a stone; thence
 S. 68 $\frac{1}{4}$ d. 16. 40 chs. to stake; thence S. 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ pl. 10. 24 chs. to
 stake in center of Laurens Road; thence with center
 of said road S. 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ pl. 20. 50 chs. to beginning, containing
 32 acres, more or less as shown on plat made
 by W. A. Hudson July 31, 1891, and being the same tract
 of land described in Deed of Charles M. Alister to
 Mary C. Beattie dated March 8, 1918 and recorded in
 C. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 42, page
 333.

The grantors herein have assumed a certain obligation
 to pay the sum of eight hundred Dollars for passing
 the portion of the Laurens Road upon which this tract
 of land abuts, and as a part of the consideration
 herein expressed the grantors herein agree to assume
 and pay said obligation.
