DEED TO Walter M. Goldsmith

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, B. H. Deason of
Greenville Countyin the State aforesaid,
Ten & 7/100 (\$10.00) Dollars & other Valuable Consideration DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by Walter M. Goldsmith

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Walter M. Goldsmith, his heirs and assigns forever:-
 All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land
 in the County and State aforesaid, near the city
 of Greenville, on the northeast side of the Augusta Road,
 containing five and one-hundredths acres, more or less,
 as per plat by R. C. Dalton dated March 1919, and
 having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: - Be-
 ginning at a point on the said road at corner of
 tract No. 1 on said plat; thence along line of tract No. 1
 N. 58-34 E. 180.6 feet to pipe corner on tract No. 1; thence S.
 24-31 E. 126.5 feet to pipe corner on tract No. 3; thence
 along line of No. 3 S. 58-40 E. 124.7 feet to pipe corner
 on Augusta Road; thence along said road N. 58-38 W. 131
 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same
 tract of land conveyed to me by F. C. Lupton and W. R.
 Lupton by their deed dated February 3rd 1920, to be recorded.
 As a part of the consideration of this conveyance the
 grantee, Walter M. Goldsmith, agrees to assume and pay
 a Mortgage given by F. C. Lupton and W. R. Lupton to D. W.
 Cochrane in the sum of twenty-five hundred & 75/100
 (\$2500.00) covering the tract of land above described.
 Interest running from the date of the Mortgage, at
 7% per annum, payable annually.
