J. Slaughter, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on Lower Street on corner of lot No. 8, and running thence with said street S. 69^o 45' E. (65) feet to a stake on corner of Cornelius Jennings lot; thence along line S. 20^o 47' E. one hundred & twenty (30) feet to a stake on line of lot No. 5; thence N. 69^o 48' E. sixty-five (65) feet with line of lot No. 5 to stakes on corner lot No. 8; thence along line of last mentioned lot N. 20^o 47' W. one hundred & two (120) feet to the beginning corner, seventy-eight hundred (7800) sq. ft.
