the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *H. P. Mc Gee* his heirs and assigns forever the following

described real estate: All that piece parcel or tract of land, lying and being in Saluda Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 12 1/2 acres more or less, adjoining lands of Gen Hunt Jackson Green and others and being the same tract of land conveyed to *P. D. Dickey* and *J. H. Hunt* by *P. D. Dickey*, sheriff of Greenville County, by deed dated Oct 25 1899 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 312 at page 564
