the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said,

J. B. Wasson, his heirs and assigns forever, the aforesaid described real estate, to wit

All that certain piece parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, containing 93 acres, more or less, and having the following lines and boundaries,

Beginning at a stone only bounded corner Sam Harrison's lands, running thence N. 29° 4' E. 20.50 chs. to a stone, thence S. 65° 4' E. 15.83 chs. to a stone, thence S. 27° 4' W. 23.98 chs. to a stone, thence S. 60° E. 18.88 chs. to a stone, thence N. 8° 1/2 W. 51.62 to corner in aforesaid tract, thence with bounds to beginning corner as is fully shown by plat made December 20, 1909 by J.
