Township, County and State aforesaid; Beginning at a stone
on said road and running thence N. 58 E. 4 chs. to stake;
thence S. 40 1/2 E. 6.5-0 chs. to white oak; thence S. 66 1/2 W. 4.25
chs. to red oak on Jones Gap Road; thence with Jones
Gap Road to the beginning corner."
