I, E. L. Lummus,

Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, A. D. Potter,

on or about the 3rd day of November in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-one, exhibited his complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against A. D. Woodle, et al.

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 13th

day of December 1921, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court,

whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate Master in and for the County aforesaid, of the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree,

as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

for the sum of One Thousand Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. L. Lummus,

Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, to me paid by the said C. C. McCall,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said,

C. C. McCall, and his heirs and assigns, forever, the following described real estate:

"All that certain lot of land lying and being in Ward 5 of the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, fronting 57 feet on Ware St., and running back therefrom 130 feet, at right angles to said street to a lot formerly owned by Mary L. Pack and by her conveyed to Frances R. Coleman, bounded on the north by lot sold by Mary L. Pack to Georgia M. Cochran; on the east by lot sold by Mary M. Pack to Frances C. Coleman; on the south by lot formerly owned by W. H. Northrop."

Also, all that other lot of land in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid and in City of Greenville: Beginning at a stake on Wake Street, at corner of lot owned by Isabell Thomas and running thence along Ward Street 14 feet to corner of lot formerly owned by W. C.
