to me paid by the said H.C. Wood
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release
unto the said.

H.C. Wood, and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real-estate:
"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Highland
Township, in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, containing 66-80/100
acres, more or less, and known and designated as Tract No. 1 as shown by a survey and plat
of the estate of A.L. Campbell made by R.E. Dalton, Engr. in October 1921, and having the
following metes and bounds and courses and distances:
Beginning at a stake on Beaverdam Creek, at corner of J.Hawkins property, and running thence
S. 6.00 W. 477 feet to stone; thence S. 5.10 W. 1530 feet to a stone; thence S. 89.15
E. 700 feet to a stone; thence S. 49.20 E. 1450 feet to a stone; thence N. 7.00 W. 957 feet
