the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Relented, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. N. Wrenn, all my right, title and unencumbered one-half interest of, in and to, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in (part) Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on Hintel Bridge Road and Armstrong Creek, containing 7 1/2 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on Hintel line and running thence N. 10° 26'. 7.00 chains, to an iron bar; thence again with N. 10° 26'. 15. 57 chains to stake on Armstrong Creek; thence with said creek S. 27 1/2 E. 3.18 chains to stake; thence S. 46 1/2 E. 12.16 chains to a stone; thence S. 8 1/2 E. 6.22 chains to a sycamore on Hintel Bridge Road; thence with said road S. 8 1/2 E. 4.92 chains to the beginning corner.
