All the one half undivided interest in that certain, piece of land or tract of land situate, lying and being in Plays Mountain Township in County and State aforesaid containing one hundred and eighty six acre, (186) more or less, and being on the top of Hogback Mountain, known as the Pioneer Cutler's tract; being near the corner of the hill side by the heirs of the late L. H. Wilcox to R. E. Brown and near the lands of Sophia Lindsey, et al., having the following lines and boundaries, to wit:- Beginning at a Forked Chestnut and running thence 8.55 U.
