(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

C. S. Hall, his heirs and assigns:
All that tract of land situate in the county of Greenville state of South Carolina, adjoining lands of Alfred Ward and others.

First tract: Beginning on a snowwood A. Wards corner on the east side of the state road or Sulphur Springs road and running westwardly with the branch, across the creek to a stake; thence southwardly with A. Wards line to the beginning, containing 3/4th of an acre, more or less.

Second tract: Beginning on George Potts rock corner on east side of state road and running with said road north five poles to a prominent point on the bank of the road; thence with meandering old road creek easterly to the mouth of the branch therefrom; said branch in an easterly direction to its source; thence to a stake (Alfred Ward's line); thence south with Alfred Ward's line to George Potts line; thence southwardly with his line to the beginning, containing four acres, more or less.

Third tract: Beginning at a stake on east side of the state road, George Potts corner near his house and running with said state road north forty-five feet 4 1/2 rods on east side of the state road near a branch, thence N. 54 E. 7.50 to a poplar on the branch; thence northeast up said branch 5 chains to a fall at the confluence of two branches; thence N. 37 E. 10.50 chains to a black gum on Alfred Ward's line; thence with Alfred Ward's line S. 39 E. 7.37 to a black gum on said line; thence S. 37 W. 9 chains to a stake down with the branch; thence with said branch S. 45 W. five chains to a stake; thence west said branch with George Potts line, crossing the creek to the beginning, containing 1/4 acre more or less.

Fourth tract: Beginning on George Potts line east side of the state road and running north with said road 8 rods to a rock corner; thence easterly across the bottom to an old chestnut tree; thence on a straight line to Alfred Ward's line; thence south to George Potts line; thence with said line to the beginning, containing ten acres more or less.

All of the above tracts of land being the same conveyed to me by C. H. Thompson and others by deed recorded in Vol. 300 page 382.
