point in the West side of Fairmount St. 90 ft. from S. Main St. running  
thence N. 41° 06' W. 100 ft. to a corner pipe, 90 ft. from the North side of S. Main  
St. thence N. 36° 47' W. 20 ft. thence N. 41° 06' E. 100 ft. to another pipe in Fairmount  
St. thence with Fairmount St. 390 ft. to the property of Mrs. M. Walker Co. as shown on  
Cint. Map July 19 1919, said lot having been conveyed to me by Mrs. M.
