all that certain piece of land and lot of land  
being and being situate on the south side of Coffee  
Street in Ward 5, in the city of Greenville, and being  
one of the lots conveying to us by Wm. Henderson and  
J. O. Hobbs, in their deed dated January 1st, 1920, and  
recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County  
in Book 54 at Page 348. Said lot bearing at a point on  
East College Street at corner of lot belonging to the Grantors  
at a point 47.4 feet from the West side of Brown Street
