B.B. Crisp his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot land situated on the north side of West Stone Avenue, in Block located between Milton and Robinson Street, and known as Lot 9 on Map No. 5 of a subdivision of the Stone Land, said map being recorded in Vol. 34, page 604 R.M.C. office of Greenville County, having the following tract and boundaries: Beginning at a point on said Stone Avenue, one hundred sixty-three (163) feet from the northeast corner of said Stone Avenue and Robinson Street; thence 51.53 feet two hundred (200) feet to a stake, thence S. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. fifty-four and one-third (54 $\frac{1}{3}$) feet to a stake (the said stake being southwest corner of lot "K" in said tract) thence S. 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. two hundred (200) feet to a stake on line of Stone Avenue; thence with lot mentioned Street N. 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. fifty-four and one-third (54 $\frac{1}{3}$) feet to the beginning corner. Reference being had to said plat will more fully appear. heirs and assigns, forever.




