(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. C. Harper, All that certain lot of land situated in  
the Township and County of Greenville, State of South  
Carolina, just beyond the City limits of Greenville, S.C.  
beginning at a Stake on the South side of Hampton  
Avenue at the East corner of the lot sold by A. G.  
Dowler to W. H. Davidson and Jessie W. Duncan by  
deed dated August 9th 1904 and recorded in R.M.C.  
Office for Greenville County in Vol. 71, page 425;  
thence North line of said lot 35'-10 1/2"-16 1/2" feet to a  
stake; thence with line to said lot 3' 6 1/2"-23 feet  
to a Stake; or the right of way of the Southern Railway  
thence with line of said right of way 27'-3 1/2"-20 feet  
to a Stake; thence leaving said East 61 feet to the  
Stake; thence 27'-6 1/2"-30 1/2" feet on South side of  
Hampton Avenue; thence with line of said street  
7'-3 1/2"-5 1/2" feet to the beginning of corner

agrees to pay said interest from the date of said  
mortgage.

Rents, taxes and insurance premiums are  
to be prorated as of the date of this conveyance.
