(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Fred H. Plewes, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on the Branch Tract or River Creek Waters of South Tiger River, said River, the following miles, and bounds according to a New and Accurate Survey made by J. G. Neve, Oct 1920 beginning at a stone corner near the Ridge road the corner of J. H. Morgan's Land and running thence S. 70° 34' 11.88 chs. to stone, thence S. 60° 37.4 chs. to a stake, thence S. 21° 30' 1.95 chs. to a stone corner of J. H. Morgan's Land, thence S. 14° 27.14.75 chs. to a stone corner of Spanish Oak, thence S. 83° 11' 43.36 chs. to a chestnut, (house) thence S. 8° E. 18.60 chs. to a stake, thence S. 83° W. 6.50 chs. to a stone, corner of A. French's land, thence S. 27.30 N. 6.50 chs. to Sweet Gum on the branch, thence S. 55° E. 3.60 chs. to an angle in branch, thence S. 86.30° E. 3.14 chs. to an angle in branch, thence S. 67.45° E. 2.14 chs. to a stake in branch, thence S. 8° E. 15.90 chs. to a stake, top of hill corner of land formerly owned by J. G. Neve, thence S. 58.30° E. 10 chs. to Red Oak (house), thence along line of Pittman's line S. 34.45° E. 43.67 chs. to a stone corner of Robert Pittman's land, thence N. 45.51° E. 1 ch. to stone, thence N. 17° E. 11.50 chs. to White Oak corner, thence N. 48° W. 20 chs. to the beginning corner.

Being the same tract of land conveyed to me by A. E. Payne by deed dated March 26, 1920, recorded in R. S. C. office for Greenville County, in Vol. 68, page 99.

As a part of the consideration for this deed the grantee herein releases and agrees to pay certain mortgage executed by J. H. Kirkpatrick to A. E. Payne in the sum of \$4000.00 dated March 26, 1920, recorded in Vol. 23, page 272, said mortgage payable as follows: \$2000 on or before one year from date and \$200 on or before two years from date, interest at 7% payable annually.

The grantee assumes payment of interest account of said mortgage from date of this conveyance.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said *Fred H. Plewes, his* heirs and assigns, forever.

AND *I myself, my* do hereby bind *his* heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said *Fred H. Plewes,*

*me* *my* heirs and assigns, against and heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
