 designated as lot No. 38 of block "B" of Cagle Park  
 as shown by plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office  
 for Greenville County in Plat book "C" page 238,  
 and having the following metes and bounds,  
 to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the south  
 side of Gindal Ave. corner off lot No. 37 & 38 and  
 running thence S. 4° 10' E. 150.3 feet to an iron pipe  
 thence S. 89.07 E. 50 feet to an iron pipe; thence  
 N. 8.21 E. 151.3 feet to an iron pipe on Gindal Ave-  
 nue; thence along Gindal Ave. N. 89.07 E. 61 feet  
 to the beginning corner - subject, however, to the
