Moore, all those lots or parcels of land lying and being in the state and county aforesaid, on the east side of the "Monticello" Road, about one mile north of Greenville, and known as Lots nos. 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 on a plat made by Prof. R. C. Janes, and recorded in Plat Book No. 1 page 358 in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, S.C. reference thereto add will fully appear. The above described property is a part of what is known as the "Pennington Place". Also, all that other pieces, parcels or lots of land beginning at an iron pier on Monticello Road, nearly West (across branch), 176 feet to an iron pier, thence up branch 292 feet to cedar top branch, thence nearly east 176 feet to cedar of Monticello Road, thence nearly north with said road to the beginning corner 319 feet, being the same tract of land conveyed to me by W.
