all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, adjoining the sold *J. W. Poling* place, *with* *A. M. Camin*, *Wm D. Batson*, and others, containing four-
teen and one-half acres, more or less, See deed recorded in
Book 999, page 850, in office of Register *Wm. Conveyance*
for Greenville County.

Also that other piece, parcel or lot of land in the County
and State aforesaid, on the head waters of Enoree River,
adjoining lands now or formerly belonging to *J. W. Batson*,
Bell Silboath and *Margaret Brown*, containing ninety-seven
acres, more or less, less three and one-fifth acres here-
