Beginning a stone marking a corner in the boundary between M. A. Smith and The Pelham Mills; thence N 57° 35' E 477 feet to a pine 31 about 100 feet from the water's edge of Conore River; thence up the said river at some distance therefrom along the following courses N 62° 44' W 218 feet, N 73° 10' W 240 feet, N 72° 58' W 209 feet, thence S 87° 16' W 415 feet, N 40° 25' W 406 feet and N 65° 36' W 100 feet to a stone at the foot of Watercates; thence along boundary of the lands of M.
