in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said R. L. Cruikshank

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All my right title and interest, the same being an undivided one-seventh interest, in and to all that piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and state aforesaid in the City of Greenville on the south side of Pendleton St. between Augusta Street and the S. & C. Railway track. Beginning at a stake on Pendleton Street at the corner of land now all jointly owned by Hill and running thence with his line S. 22 E. 68 feet to a stake whence N. 69 E. 72 feet to a stake whence N. 22 W. 68 feet to a stake on Pendleton Street, thence with Pendleton St. S. 69 W. 74 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to B. J. Bates, Trustee for the Benefit of himself, R. L. Cruikshank, J. M. Richardson, W. A. Wallace, Frank R. Hersey, J. C. Martin and Geo. C. Hersey by J. E. Payne, and conveyed to me by W. E. Gardner on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of September, and recorded in R. M. C. Office in Vol. 62 at page 288. As a part of the consideration for this deed the Grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay that portion of a certain mortgage for which the Grantor herein would be liable. Said mortgage having been executed by J. B. Bates, R. L. Cruikshank et al to J. E. Payne on the 6<sup>th</sup> of October 1919, in the sum of \$14,146.48 and recorded in Vol. 77 at page 233, bearing interest at the rate of 6% per annum, payable semi-annually. Said mortgage be payable as follows: On Oct 6th 1921 \$4,715.50 on Oct 6th 1922 \$4,715.49 and on Oct 6th 1923 \$4,715.49.

Also as a part of the consideration for this conveyance the Grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay a certain note and mortgage in the amount of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars given to J. C. Harper by W. E. Gardner dated Aug. 8th 1921, and recorded in R. M. C. Office Vol. 97, page 96 bearing interest at the rate of 8% per annum, interest payable semi-annually.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by Sept. 1st the same day of 1921, deed recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book Vol. 62 Page 288.  
TOGETHER with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said R. L. Cruikshank, his heirs and assigns forever.
