McCain tract, containing seventy-six (76) acres, more or less, as described in a deed from W.L. McCain to Judson Henderson, book PP., at page 417, office R.M.C. Greenville County; and second tract known as the I.F. Reese, tract and containing thirty-three and one-third (33-1/3) acres, more or less, as will appear from deed recorded in Book LLL, at page 174, Greenville County; and described more particularly as follows:

Tract No. 1 - Beginning at a stone 3x near the mouth of branch on the north bank of South Tyger River and runs thence S. 57-2 E. 15-66 chs. to a stone or dogwood 3x; thence N. 40-3/4 E. 21-80 chs. to a stone; thence N. 19 E. 25-72 to a stone 3x; thence N. 54 W. 20-14 to a stone 3x; thence S. 55 W. 13-36 chs. to a stone; thence S. 29 E. 34-65 to a stone 3x; thence S. 55 W. 35-58 to Jenkins corner on South Tyger River; thence down said river to the beginning corner.

Second tract - Beginning on the center of the road, known as the Jenkins Road at a stone, in the line of the Northeastern end of tract No. 1, and runs thence Southeast 117 P.
