Gant - All that piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in Ward Two of the City of Greenville on the Northwest side of Mc Gee Street and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a point on Mc Gee Street (which is 214 feet from the Northwest corner of Mc Gee St. & East Ave.) and running thence N. 21-45 W. 51 feet with Mc Gee St. to a corner; thence S. 80-00 W. 155 feet to a corner on the east side of a ten foot alley; thence S. 21-45 E. along the east side of said ten foot alley 51 feet to a corner thence S. 80-00 E. 155 feet to the point of beginning and being known and designated as Lot no. 63, according to a plat of the Rowley Place, which is recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. This being the same lot conveyed to me by Sara R. Wannamaker by deed dated January 31, 1920 and recorded in R. M. C. The Grantee herein is to assume the payment of said Mortgage indebtedness according to the terms and conditions contained in the said mortgage.
