The person whose a party acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the
said Bill Finley all that certain piece parcel or lot of
land situate, lieing and being in the County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina in the West side of the Anderson
Road about one eighth of one mile from the incorporate
limits of the City of Greenville and having the following
writings and bounds to wit:

Beginning at a stake 46° on Anderson Road and
running thereof N. 52 1/2 W. 12-32 to a rock 20' thence S. 35 1/2
E. 16' to a rock 46, thence S. 53 1/2 E. 11-64 to a stake 20' on
the said Anderson road thence along said road N. 52 1/2 E.
16' to the beginning corner leck that piece parcel or lot of
land 2.0000000000000002 acres out of the above boundaries by deed to J. W.
Whitton, dated March 21st 1908 and recorded in R. M. C. Office
for Greenville County in Deed Book 94 Vol. 36 at page 569
and described in said deed as follows:
