Dowling her heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land lying, being and situate in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina on Barton's Creek, waters of South Tyger River adjoining lands of J.A. Wood, W.A. Barton, J.H. Barton, D.H. Bates and others and containing 113 acres, more or less and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone in the fence corner on the south side of the road leading to the bottoms on the creek; thence S. 37 W. 15.57 chs. to a stone on J.A. Woods line; thence N. 55 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 21.35 ch. across the road to a stone near John Bellenger's (deceased) corner; thence S. 21 E. 3.60 ch. to a stone; thence S. 21 W. 10.30 ch. to a stone; thence S. 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 2.90 ch. to a stone; thence N. 85 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 17.90 ch. to an iron pin in road, W.A. Barton's corner; thence along said road N. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 5.27 ch. to an angle in road; thence N. 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3.64 ch. to an angle in road; thence N. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 2.90 ch. to a stone in said road; thence along old abandoned road N. 14 E. 2.31 ch. to a stone in old road; thence N. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 1.00 ch. to a stone in old road; thence N. 17 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 6.11 ch. to a stone in old road; thence N. 20 E. 3.59 ch. to a stone in old road; thence N. 32 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 2.76 ch. to a stone in old road; thence N. 18 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 1.00 ch. to a stone in old road; thence N. 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 2.47 ch. to a stone in old road; thence N. 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 1.67 ch. to a stone in old road; thence N. 13 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 1.50 ch. to a stone in old road; thence N. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 3.42 ch. to stone in old road; thence N. 36 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 0.65 links to the center of the road leading from the state road to the Columbia Road; thence along a road leading to J.H. Barton's N. 32 W. 2.50 ch. to an angle in road; thence N. 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 4.80 ch. to an iron pin in road, W.A. Barton's corner; thence N. 68 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 7.18 ch. to a stone; thence S. 72 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 7.22 ch. to a stone still on J.H. Barton's line; thence S. 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 13.27 ch. to a stone on J.H. Barton's line; thence N. 45 E. 43 links on Barton's line to a sycamore tree on branch; thence down the creek along D.H. Bates line to an iron wood tree on creek; thence N. 89 W. 3.90 ch. to a poplar tree on the plantation road; thence along said road to the beginning corner.
