the certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate on the
north side of Crescent (formerly Miller's) Avenue, in the sixth
ward of the city of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, known
and designated as lot #19 of Block "B" of Eagle Park as shown
on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County on
that book at page 239, and being more fully described
as follows:

Begins at an iron pin on the north side of Crescent
(formerly Miller's) Avenue, joint corner of lots #19 and 20, and
thence with line of lot #19 and 20 N. 0-23 E. 55.9
feet to an iron pin on rear line of lot #26, thence with the
back line of lots #26 and 27 N. 44-44 W. 64.3 feet to an iron
pin corner of lot #18, thence with line of lot #18 S. 0-06 E.
243.6 feet to an iron pin on Crescent (formerly Miller's) Avenue;
thence along the north side of said Avenue S. 62-52 E. 68
feet to the beginning corner, this being the same lot of
