TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. Lussman Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Solomon Whicker

on or about the 17th day of May in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and nineteen exhibited his complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Elisha Parsh and Elias Parsh

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 29th day of July 1922, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said.

Elisha Parsh and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, or lot of land in the County and State aforesaid in the City of Greenville, and above the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in Buncombe Street also Johnson's corner and running thence N. 56 E. 141 feet to iron pin; thence N. 34 1/4 W. 28 feet to iron pin on 21 foot alley; thence S. 67 1/4 W. 145 feet to iron pin in line with Buncombe Street; thence with Buncombe Street S. 34 E. about 56 feet to the beginning corner and being the same lot of land conveyed Mary Thomas' which by D. P. Bounds, deed recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. R. S. 2, page 498.
