to me paid by the said T. W. Moon

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release  
unto the said.

T. W. Moon and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:  
"All that certain tract or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the aforesaid State and  
County, on Wild Cat Creek, waters of South Tyger River, and having the following courses  
and distances, to-wit:  
Beginning at T. W. Moon's corner, in D. W. Hughes line; thence S. 41-1/2 W. 11.18 chs. to a white  
oak on the North Bank of Jordan Road; thence S. 22-1/2 W. 6.64 chs. to W. O. 3X at Spring; thence  
down Spring branch to Wild Cat Creek; thence up the creek to a stake in the branch near the  
head; thence N. 58-1/2 W. 15.26 chs. to a stone; thence with Belcher's line N. 23-1/2 E. 4.60 chs. to
