to have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said  
parish and T. C. Gower and their heirs and assigns forever.

seal, this 29th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand, nine  
hundred and Twenty Six and in the one hundred and 50th
