the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said,

J. Lee Greene, and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate: "All that certain tract of land situate in Greenville County, South Carolina, Butler Township, near Roper Mountain Baptist Church, adjoining lands of Warren Green, J. D. Green, and others, and containing Twenty-seven (27) acres, more or less.

Also: All that other tract of land situated in the State and County aforesaid, near Roper Mountain Baptist Church, adjoining lands of Mr. Phillips, and others, and containing Two (2) acres, more or less, and being the same two tracts of land conveyed to T. A. King by J. B. Rector by deed dated December 31, 1917 and recorded in the R. I. C. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book, Vol. 52, page 151."
