did then, openly and publicly and according to the custom of auctions, sell and dispose of the said real estate described below unto *Alton B. Handler* for *Nine Hundred Seventy-five (\$975.00)* Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder for same.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said *Fannie B. Scott* as Judge of the Court of Probate as aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and also in consideration of the sum of *Nine Hundred Seventy-five (\$975.00)* Dollars,

paid me by the said *Alton B. Handler* the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Alton B. Handler*

and *his* heirs and assigns forever, all *that tract of land in Fairview Township, State and County aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning upon iron pin, and running thence N. 63° 41' 6.21" E. 20 ft to stone on branch; thence down branch N. 87° 34' 11" E. to a black gum on fork of branch; thence S. 47° 24' 11" W. to stone; thence S. 57° 12' 49" W. to a pin; thence N. 25° 24' 11" E. to the beginning corner, and containing 1.97400 acres, more or less.*

*Also a tract in said Township, State and County, Beginning at a stone on bank of branch, and running thence up the branch N. 81° 34' 11" E. to a maple; thence S. 63° 41' 6.21" E. to iron pin; thence S. 22° 46' 11" W. to iron pin; thence N. 63° 41' 6.21" E. to the beginning corner, and containing 2.34 acres, more or less, said two tracts of land all the same which were conveyed to said Frank W. Shammaon by Lewis A. Lawler, deed dated December 24, 1925, and recorded in Deed Book 109 at page 265, in the C.M.C. Office for said Greenville County.*

Shammaon, deceased* and of all the parties to the said suit, and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, by, from or under them, or either of them, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the said premises with its hereditaments, privileges and appurtenances unto the said *Alton B. Handler* *his* Heirs and Assigns forever.
