that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, near the Eastern limits of the City of Greenville, in the section known as Nickeltown, and being known as lot no. 3 of Block "B" of Jefferson Heights as shown on plat in R. M. C. Office in plat Book C. at page 34 and 35. Said lot having a frontage of 25.5 feet on Second Avenue with a depth of 81.65 feet. This is the same land conveyed to W. M.
