Know all men by these presents, that I Susan J. Graham of Greenville S.C. have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint Allen J. Graham, of Greenville S.C. my true and lawful attorney, for me and in my name and stead to make, draw, sign or indorse in my name any promissory notes or checks in which I shall be interested or concerned, or which shall be requisite in connection with my affairs; from time to time to sell and dispose of, either by public or private sale, any shares of stock I now hold or may hereafter hold, in any business corporation, or any bonds or securities of the United States or any State or Municipal Corporation or private company, and to receive the consideration money for the sale thereof, and for me and in my name to execute such transfers or assignments and shall be necessary to assign my said shares, bonds or securities to the purchaser or purchasers thereof and to demand, sue for, collect and receive any dividends or other moneys to which I may become entitled, and to pay or deposit the same in my name, or otherwise with any banker, and to draw out from time to time any moneys on deposit and invest same in the discretion of the said Attorney, and from time to time to sell, vary and dispose of such investments. And for me and in my name to sell and convey any real estate belonging to me, either by private contract or by public auction, and either together or in separate parcels or lots, for such price and on such terms as to him shall seem advisable; and he is hereby authorized to sign and seal as my act and deed any instrument in writing, and to do every other thing necessary or proper for carrying into effect and execution any agreement of sale made by him in such manner that all my estate, right, title or interest in or to the land and appurtenances included in such agreement of sale, so that the same may be effectually and absolutely conveyed and assured to the purchaser or the respective purchasers thereof, his and their heirs and assigns forever. And generally to deal with my property, both real and personal and to do and perform all acts and things which may be necessary in the conduct of my affairs. And I, the said Susan J. Graham, hereby declare, that all and every the receipts, deeds, matters and things which shall be by him, my said Attorney, given made or done for the aforesaid purposes, shall be as good, valid and effectual to all intents and purposes whatsoever as if the same had been

signed, sealed, delivered, given, made or done by me in my own proper person, and I hereby ratify whatsoever my said Attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done in the concerning the premises by virtue of these presents.
