Dill in the State aforesaid the receipt is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and released unto the said J. B. Dill my half of all that tract or piece of land situated in the above named State and County on the head waters of Facolth and adjoining lands to myself and P. D. Birsten and have such metes and bounds as follows, beginning on a chestnut known as the Buse land corner, thence east to a chestnut oak a fore and aft, tree on said line; thence south 2k to a maple; thence near north to a Lower road thence to the beginning corner, all are conditional lines and contain two acres more or less by supposition, Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to the same, I have and do hereby sell and singular one-half the premises before mentioned unto the said J. B. Dill his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors, and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J. B. Dill his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
