This instrument made and entered into this 9th day
of April 1927 by and between C. E. Roberts, Hattie V. Roberts
Virginia E. Roberts and Frances L. Roberts, all of the state
and County aforesaid, witnesseth; C. E. Roberts husband of
Hattie V. Roberts and father of Virginia E. Roberts and
Frances L. Roberts, for and in consideration of the under-
takings and agreements on the part of his said wife
and daughters, hereby agrees to pay to his said wife,
Hattie V. Roberts, the sum of two hundred fifty (\$250.00) dollars
and to his said daughters, Virginia E. Roberts and Frances
L. Roberts, one hundred twenty-five (\$25.00) each in cash
upon the signing and execution of this agreement and
til carrying out of the undertakings and agreement
of the other parties hereto. C. E. Roberts, for and in
consideration of the sum of two hundred fifty (\$250.00)
dollars paid to her by C. E. Roberts as aforesaid, does
hereby contract and agree to sign, release and relinquish
all her interest and right or claim of dower of in or to
all that certain lot of land on Lloyd Street in the City
of Greenville when so requested by the said C. E. Roberts
and property execute my deed therefor presented by the
said C. E. Roberts, as a further consideration herein, the
said Hattie V. C. Roberts does hereby release and forever dis-
charge the said C. E. Roberts of and from any and all
claim of support or contribution to her support during
her life time. Virginia E. Roberts and Frances L.
Roberts, for and in consideration of the sum of two
hundred twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars each to them paid
by the said C. E. Roberts as aforesaid, do hereby, individually
and jointly, release and discharge the said C. E. E.
Roberts of and from any claim of support or contribution
to their support as long as they as he may so live,
and further agree to withdraw any and all proceedings
civil or criminal, of whatever kind that may be now
pending against the said C. E. Roberts for their support.
The said C. E. Roberts, in addition to the above, does
hereby further agree as a part of the consideration
herein that his said wife and daughters, parties hereto
shall keep possession and occupy the home on Lloyd
Street hereinabove referred to, in which they are now
living, until the first day of May 1927, at which time
the other parties do hereby agree to vacate and deliver
possession thereof to the said C. E. Roberts or his
agents, or whomever he may designate, in a
peaceable manner. The said C. E. Roberts
further agrees that any and all furniture

household goods, articles of whatever kind or nature
now in said house shall become the property of the said
Hattie V. Roberts to dispose of as she may see fit or remove
at the time of vacating the premises, and any interest or
claim of whatever kind in the premises is hereby released
and forever abandoned by the said C. E. Roberts.

The said C. E. Roberts does further agree that this agreement
shall not be considered as an acceptance by the other parties
hereto as their distributive share of his estate at the time
of his death but that at his death the said parties hereto
shall be entitled to their respective rights and shares
in and of his estate, both real and personal, as provided
by and in accordance with the law.
