the sum aforesaid is hereby acknowledged have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Miss Jean Knight all of that certain tract of land containing One hundred and fifty one (151) acres, more or less, being on both sides of the Augusta Road, north of the home tract in State and County aforesaid, Dunklin Township, on a branch on the west tributary to Mountain Creek, waters of Saluda River, and on a branch on the east tributary to Horse Creek, waters of Pee Dee River. Beginning at a stone 3x0 on the west, thence N. 35° E. 30.75 stone 3x0 thence N. 8-3/8 E. 13.79 stone 3x0. Bounded on these two lines by a tract this day conveyed to Mr. A. Knight; thence N. 59-7/8 E. 23.70 staple 3x0 on west bank of branch. Bounded by W. V. Kirby; thence S. 78-2/3 E. 20.69 large rock 3x0. Bounded by J. Walter Thompson, thence S. 35-3/4 E. 2.88 corner in road. Bounded by a tract this day conveyed to James K. and Olive E. McCollum; thence S. 54 W. 7.08 3x0, S. 36-1/2 E. 5.81 stake 3x0, N. 69 E. 3.97 stone 3x0. Bounded on the last three lines by the Parkville Church and School lot; thence S. 36-3/4 E. 5.77 stone 3x0; thence N. 73-1/2 E. 3.41 stone 3x0; thence S. 36 E. 3.23 stake 3x0 74 links S.E. of the old corner on a school rock in the branch. Bounded from the School lot to the branch by a tract this day conveyed to James K. and Olive E. McCollum; thence S. 76-1/2 W. 77.75 to the beginning. Bounded by the home tract which is this day conveyed to Roy E. Knight. Surveyed August 15, 1925.
