W. W. Batson Jr. or his heirs, executors, heirs and assigns, tract of land lying
pertaining in State and having in Saluda Township
containing and situated as follows: containing Thirteen
acres more or less and being tract number
one, described as the boundaries of W. W. Batson
deceased, according to plat of W. W. Batson
dated November 14, 1912, plat being recorded in
the office in said book page *100* and
bearing the following metes and bounds: accord-
ing to said plat, beginning at a stone in rock
in side of road no. 15, thence with line
