Milford ... all that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being on the east side of Bennett Street in the City of Greenville and State aforesaid and having the following lines and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Bennett St., 15 ft. North of the north east corner of Bennett St. and Bennett Ave., thence along the east side of Bennett Street N. E. 18 W. 75 ft. to an iron pin; thence along line of property of W. C. Cleveland S. 66-45 E. 30° S. 6 ft. to an iron pin on rear line; thence along rear line along said property S. 11-25 E. 70-24 ft. to an iron pin on line of Clayton property, thence along line of said property N. 66-45 E. 30° S. 6 ft. to the point of beginning, same containing 0.46 acres more or less.
