2. That no residence will be placed thereon costing less than \$ 2000.00.
3. That no residence will be located nearer the street than as shown on said plan than 25 feet.
4. That no part of the within premises shall be used for commercial purposes, public garage or other.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said H. D. Harris, his

heirs and assigns, forever.
