(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said all that piece or lot of land situated in said State and County of Greenville, in the Town of Taylors, on the North side of the National Highway and on the South Side of the Piedmont and Southern Railway, adjoining lands of the said Jasper Carter Estate and R. M. Smith, running 7.400 following Metes and Bounds, viz.: Beginning at a stake, the said R. M. Smith's corner, on the edge of the said National Highway, running thence N. 45° 20' E. 300 feet to a stake on the edge of the right of-way to the said Piedmont and Northern Railway, thence along the said right-of-way about 230 feet to a stake on the edge of the said right-of-way, thence S. 28° E. 552 feet to a stake on the edge of the said National Highway, thence along the said National Highway about 222 feet to the beginning corner containing Two and twenty eight one-hundredth acres, more or less.
