B. Brown and C. H. Kinslow and being more completely described as follows: Beginning on and across in the old Rutledge Road and following the same along the said Old Rutledge Road, 6.36 W. 1027.7 feet to cross creek on bank of New Rutledge Road; thence N. 85.45 E. 1365 feet to cross said creek and of branch, thence up the line of said branch, N. 4.10 W. 158 feet to road, thence N. 10.15 W. 150 feet to road and branch, thence N. 3.49 W. 110 feet to road, thence N. 21.30 W. 199 feet to road, thence N. 2.20 W. 5 feet to corner on S.
