Hardin, do now have, or may hereafter acquire, whether by inheritance or otherwise, in the said tract of land, two tracts in the said State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in Cleveland, Township, in Matthew's Creek, and a common boundary containing in both tracts 35 acres, more or less, in small tracts, as laid out in the same as follows: bounded by the S. W. corner of the tract, dated November 20, 1906, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, Greenville County, on the 20th day of November, 1906, in which the said Sallie S. Hardin did sign and witness.
