NOW, therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, That I, E. Wallace, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred (800.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said J. P. Morgan and W. O. Grace,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. P. Morgan and W. O. Grace and their heirs and assigns forever, the following described Real Estate, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows: Beginning at the sign post on the Post Office side of an unnamed street in vicinity of lands of Sterling Brown, and running thence along the line of unnamed street S. 37° 46' E. 65 feet to another path, thence northeast 155 feet, more or less, to Emma Williams' line, thence along said line N. 57° 28' 44" 39 feet, more or less, to line of Sterling Brown, thence along Sterling Brown's line, S. 11° 47' 44" W. 155 feet to the beginning of another path, thence northward 155 feet, more or less, to land represented by a plat recorded, in Plat Book "C" page 30, in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Greenville County, showing that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, originally owned by John White (now Russell Edgington), then lost his title to the North half, lands formerly owned by John White (now Russell Edgington) then lost his title to the North half, lands formerly owned by C.
