The South Carolina National Bank, a corporation its successors and assigns forever, the following described real estate: All that tract of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, commencing at the Hickory on Rocky Creek and running thence with the Vaughan line No. 27, 0.00, N. 38° 70' to west side: Then 76.00 N. 24° 30' to a light wood stake; thence S. 22° 0' E. 41° 0' 2 to a poplar on creek; thence north Rocky Creek to the beginning corner, being the same tract of land conveyed to J. S. Spearman by H. S. Miller and Mrs. J. M. Carter by deed dated February 26, 1920. Said tract containing 1.27 acre more or less. Also, that other tract of land in the Township, County aforesaid, containing .89 acres more or less according to a plat made by A. S.
